Ed and Debbie together presented the YMCA latest project to provide facility renovations at the Pataskala Branch. Phase I will cost \$2.8 million and provide an expanded wellness center, locker rooms, family changing areas, flexible program space, community space, expanded studios, expanded child watch, expanded program areas, removal of loading docks, centralized entrance and a uniform façade. Phase II will cost \$1.1 million and provide a gymnasium. Phase II will begin after Phase I financial goal is met. They ask the Board for a letter of support.

-Mark Van Buren moved to provide the YMCA with a letter of support from the Board of Trustees for facility renovations. Ray Foor seconded the motion. Roll call: Smith YES, Van Buren YES and Foor YES. The motion passed.

### From the floor – Jarrod Mahaffey

Mr. Mahaffey was in attendance representing the Harrison Meadows Homeowners Association. He is concerned about Lot #5 in Phase I of Harrison Meadows. The address is 6381 Watkins Road and the resident is operating some kind of Construction Company from his home. He has recently purchased Lot #5 and has started parking construction equipment on this lot. He has surfaced the lot and filled in a ditch. His home is zoned Manufacturing and Lot #5 is zoned R-15. He feels that this is a change in use on Lot #5. Tom Frederick will research the zoning on Lot #5. Mr. Mahaffey's second concern is Lot #35 in Harrison Meadows where an accessory building has been placed in a no build zone. The township issued the permit under R-15 zoning. A no build zone is a deed restriction and should be pursued by the Homeowners Association. -Mark Van Buren moved to approve the following:

Road Report – Ben Patterson, Road Superintendent

Ben reported that the Citation Drive Culvert Project has encountered a gas line issue. The gas lines needs moved and Ben will work with the gas company.

Ben explained that he needs to hire a company to cut out sections of pavement to repair certain roads in preparation of the resurfacing project. Ben presented an estimate from Donley Concrete Cutting & Drilling Company to flat saw 688' of 10" pavement at \$3.00 per foot for a total of \$2,064.00.

### -Mark Van Buren moved to approve a purchase order for \$3,000.00 to Donley Concrete Cutting & Drilling Company to repair roads. Eric Smith seconded the motion. Roll call: Smith YES, Van Buren YES and Foor YES. The motion passed.

From the floor – Alan Haines, City of Pataskala Service Director

Mr. Haines attended the meeting to discuss Hazelwood North (30+ homes) and the cul-de-sac's. They discussed if they should be private streets or public streets. The trustees are interested in working with the City of Pataskala in solving potential issues with the roads.
