 Proposed: No flickering or flashing lights shall be permitted, except for temporary
- holiday decorations. 4. Convert measurement chart from Foot Candles to Lumens.

Add 14.4 Outdoor Lighting Definitions

<u>Glare</u>: Direct light emitted by a luminaire that causes reduced vision or momentary blindness. <u>Light Trespass</u>: Light emitted by a luminaire that shines beyond the boundaries of the property on which the luminaire is located.

Lumen: a unit of measure of light.

<u>Shielded light fixture</u>: a fixture for which direct illumination from the light source (e.g., light bulb) is not visible when the fixture is viewed along a line parallel with the ground at the height of the fixture. (Add a figure to this definition to illustrate)

Discussion of proposed changes to Article 4 Administration will be on hold until the BZA gives their opinion on what is needed. The next BZA hearing and meeting is in the process of being scheduled.

At 8:30 p.m. Ms. Miller moved to adjourn. Mr. Osborne seconded. The motion passed with unanimous ayes.
