Tom reported that he signed off on a notice of application for a re-plat to be considered by the Licking County Planning Commission. The property located on Ponder Place is currently owned by Kenneth and Janice Roslan.

Tom reported that the Licking County Planning Commission conditionally approved Application #2017-048-V for Jeremy Nestor, parcel #025-068958-01.000 for driveway spacing.

Road Report – Ben Patterson, Road Superintendent

Ben reported that Leo Conkel has prepared the bid packet for the Harrison Township Sanitary Sewer Service Improvement Project. Details were discussed and the estimate from Mr. Conkel stated that the project should bid under \$50,000.00. The County Prosecutor is reviewing the bid packet.

Ray Foor seconded the motion. Roll call: Smith YES, Van Buren YES and Foor YES. The motion passed.

Discussion took place concerning cutting trees in the road right of way. Ben felt that the Board should wait until the first of the year to hire someone. He did not think that the work could be completed in December with winter weather coming on. Ben thought that one more round of cutting trees in the road right of way would have the township roads under control. Ben will obtain an estimate from Tree King to review later.

Ben reviewed details of a culvert north of Refugee Road on Smoke Road. The culvert is large and deep, Ben would like to have this project bid out.

-Mark Van Buren moved to adopt Resolution 2017 12 04 01 which states: IN THE MATTER OF DECLARING THE NECESSITY FOR CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING, OR IMPROVEMENT OF SMOKE ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT. The motion further states that the Board is requesting engineering for this project from the Licking County Engineer. Ray Foor seconded the motion. Roll call: Smith YES, Van Buren YES and Foor YES. The resolution was adopted.

Ben reported that the Licking County Engineer stated that the drainage issues on Ashcraft Drive would have to be solved by a ditch petition. The Engineer will meet with Ben on December 5th at 9:00 a.m.

7:00 p.m. – The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Harrison Township was stopped to hold the Public Hearing for the Harrison Meadows Light Petition.

7:15 p.m. – The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Harrison Township is now back in session.

Road Report – continued by Ben Patterson

Ben reviewed issues that have arisen when trying to flush culverts. The township needs to use a water meter and be granted permission to use the fire hydrant.

From the floor – Larry Kretzmann, SWLCW&SD

Mr. Kretzmann reviewed ongoing projects for the district. He stated that the 2018 budget will have an extra 3% increase and that revenue will have a 1% or 2% increase. The new water plant is on track to finish by the end of 2018.

Trustee Van Buren reported that the West Licking Fire Board spent 1.5 million on the Arc Building. They rebid the dirt work for the station on Morse Road. RJ Construction will build the station which will have two bays with sleeping quarters.

-Mark Van Buren moved to appoint Anthony Sharp to a five year term (starting Jan. 1, 2018) on the Harrison Township Zoning Commission. Ray Foor seconded the motion. Roll call: Smith YES, Van Buren YES and Foor YES. The motion passed.

-Eric Smith moved to approve revising the revenue account status for the following accounts:

Ray Foor seconded the motion. No appropriations were changed. Roll call: Smith YES, Van Buren YES and Foor YES. The motion passed.

The fiscal officer presented a letter from the Department of Commerce stating that all alcoholic beverage permits will expire on February 1, 2018. No trustees had an objection with the renewal of all permits.

The Ohio Township Association Winter Conference is January 31 through February 3, 2018. Carolyn Elder, Mark Van Buren and Ray Foor will attend the conference.

The fiscal officer received a letter from the Ohio History Connection stating that the Outville Hay & Grain Company Building is being considered by the Ohio Historic Site Preservation Advisory Board for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places.

Health Insurance renewal was discussed.

-Eric Smith moved to renew Harrison Township's Health Insurance Policy with Anthem with an annual cost of \$109,773.00. This policy has a \$5,000/\$10,000 deductible which will be covered by the township with a HRA account. Ray Foor seconded the motion. Roll call: Smith YES, Van Buren YES and Foor YES. The motion passed.

From the floor – Jennifer Noble Jennifer stated that the Outville Christmas Parade is on Saturday, December 9th starting at 3:00 p.m. with lineup at 1:30 p.m. The Grand Marshall will be the Outville Presbyterian Church.

- -Mark Van Buren moved to go into Executive Session at 9:00 p.m. for the purpose of appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, compensation or the investigation of charges against a public employee or official, etc. Ray Foor seconded the motion. Roll call: Smith YES, Van Buren YES and Foor YES. The motion passed.
- -Mark Van Buren moved to return to Regular Session from Executive Session at 9:47 p.m. Ray Foor seconded the motion. Roll call: Smith YES, Van Buren YES and Foor YES. The motion passed.

The Fiscal Officer read various pieces of correspondence and passed out Financial Reports for the trustees to review. The trustees reviewed and signed the December bank statements. The Statement of Pooled Securities as of October 31, 2017 was reviewed.

Being no further business, Chairman Eric Smith adjourned the meeting at 9:53 p.m. Minutes are unofficial until approved by the trustees.
